Children's Centre Improvement Partners

Working with Children's Centres in London Boroughs of Waltham Forest and Islington as part of a joint CCIP project to support the governance and delivery of effective programmes. Delivering to the Ofsted agenda and to ensure that Children's Centres are in a position for successful inspection. This has impacted on the Children's Centres taking part in the project receiving good or above categories.

Using the Self Evaluation Model as the route to create ownership of Children's Centre activities and delivery and as a way to engender the SEF as the catalyst in providing all evidence needed and that the communities needs are being met.

By working with all the staff and involved people we can ensure that it is more than just a paper exercise but is the central core in all documentation and provision of services.

Children's Centre Interim Management

A Children Centre in London Borough of Wandsworth was in need of interim management when the manager had been on sick leave for over 9 months.

Working with the Centre directly as manager to engage with the staff and volunteers and families, to lift morale and to find ways to ensure that the Centre increased it's profile in the local community of disadvantage.

Part of my role was also to ensure that all the governance and documentation was current and used the statistical data to show the correlation between services, activities and family needs.

Completed the Centre Action Plans, policies and the SEF, working with other centres.

Our Partnership also delivered a number of literacy projects for children and families. We also are currently engaging with them for the establishment of websites.
